

# Materials to Bring to PSIA Competition

<b>Event</b>	<b><i>Materials to Bring to Testing Location</i></b>
<b>Art Memory</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
<b>Calculator Applications</b>	Any silent, hand-held, tapeless calculator and pencil
<b>Creative Writing</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen (5-6 sheets of lined paper provided)
<b>Impromptu Speaking</b>	Writing Utensil and Blank Paper (to initially organize ideas on; may not be used when giving speech)
<b>Listening Skills</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; 2 Sheets of Blank Paper (with or without lines)
<b>Maps, Graphs &amp; Charts</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; An atlas (Nystrom Desk Atlas 2007 or newer addition), a ruler, and a magnifying glass (can be brought into the test)
<b>Mathematics</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers
<b>Music Memory</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
<b>Number Sense</b>	Blue (ONLY) ball point or ink pen
<b>On-site Drawing</b>	Drawing media (CANNOT require water, oil or a brush); Watercolor markers acceptable; Other acceptable media: pencil, charcoal, craypas, pastels, and ink pens (not requiring a separate bottle of ink)
<b>Prose or Poetry Interpretation</b> (depending on year)	Small, Dark colored folder (class folder with brads and pockets) containing individual Prose or Poetry work with Verification Documentation in the pocket
<b>Ready Writing</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; Notebook Paper
<b>Science</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
<b>Spelling</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
<b>Vocabulary</b>	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen

Watches for contests are okay, but there cannot be any beeping or alarms going off. If it is not listed here, it has not been approved by the officials.
