### November 18, 2020

A meeting of the Advisory Council (the "Council") of Christ the King Catholic School ("CKS") was held on November 18, 2020 commencing at 6:00 p.m. (Central Standard Time) via a Zoom virtual meeting.

#### **Attendance**

## **Minute Approval**

Mr. Raymond made a motion to approve the September 16, 2020 minutes, which was seconded by Ms. Snyder.

## **Church Update - Father Tony**

Father Tony provided an update on the Church, noting the Christmas Eve schedule (still 50% capacity) will have more services given the capacity limits as well as using the Community Center, registrations (will be announced during mass), the 930 and 11am masses have been using the overflow in the Community Service. He also stated that he and Father Ryan continue to visit the kids during school on a regular basis.

### **School Update**

Dr. Bosco provided an update on the on the lowa Assessments & CogAT - Fall 2020 results, on a grade by grade basis, which generally were positive across the board, including Longitudinal results (which are indicating growth across time for each class cohort) as well as significant growth in ELA, reading scores and strong growth in the upper school. Focus areas coming out of the testing include: math concepts and computation and phonics and score interpretations by student are available to be discussed in more detail (at parent's request). Tarpley Prep practice tests for 8th grade students have started, which includes a process to meet with the students individually discuss the results.

### **CKSPA Report**

In Mrs. Kidwell's absence, Mr. Tusa provided an update on the CKSPA.

  - Grade with the most bags- homework pass, possible cookie
- December 9th- CKSPA Faculty sponsored holiday dinner

### **Committee Updates**

- Health / Wellness update Dr. Tolle provided an update on COVID environment, continue to focus on keeping kids in schools and keep the proper protocols in place.
- Finance update No significant updates from the September meeting and it is expected that the school will meet or outperform the budget for the academic year.
- Academic Mr. Galante deferred noting the committee was set to meet subsequent to the date of the November 18, 2020 Council meeting.
- Facilities Mr. Tusa provided an update on the filed drainage improvements, which
  included a timeline to be finished before the Christmas Holiday (weather permitting) and
  noted that once the drainage project is completed the School will continue to look into
  better security fencing for the field.
  - Considering plans for awnings/coverings to help provide additional space outside in Franny's Garden
- Catholic Identity Father Tony provided an update, noting that he and Father Ryan
  continue to visit with the students on a weekly basis, pray with them (as promised at the
  beginning of the school year). This has been well received by the students so far. In
  addition, Father Tony noted the Food Drive was very successful and a recent discussion
  that was led by Father Joshua Clemmons on holy ground was very well received.
