



- Families that have children in multiple grades **MUST** drop each child at their designated drop area and then transition as shown with the dotted lines to the next drop area. Each family can choose the route and drop off sequence that works best for their family.



### **RED/PRESTON ROUTE**

- Families can choose the route (red or green) that is most convenient for them.
- **No walk-ups allowed.** Parents/caregivers must remain in their cars. CKS personnel will call for each student/family to be dismissed when their car arrives to the front of the line.
- Carpool tags must be visible in the front windshield. Multi-family or activity carpools must be organized with the office in advance.
- A parent's directive for their child to leave school with a non-family member must be received in written form to the students homeroom teacher by **no later than 2:30pm.**
- No cellphone use during active carpool.
- Do not block the sidewalk or passing traffic on Douglas Ave.
- No CKS parking permitted in adjacent Chase Bank/Office lot. Be considerate of our adjacent residents and businesses.
- Drive slow and be cautious, courteous and patient with other drivers when merging, entering and exiting the lines.
