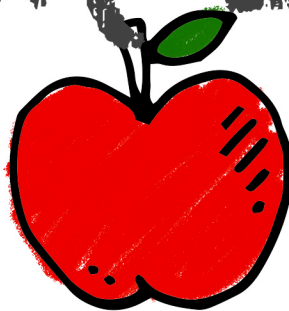

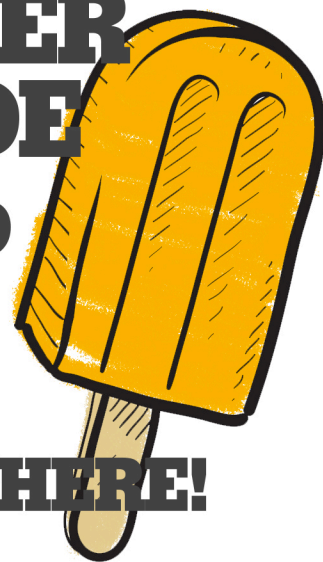

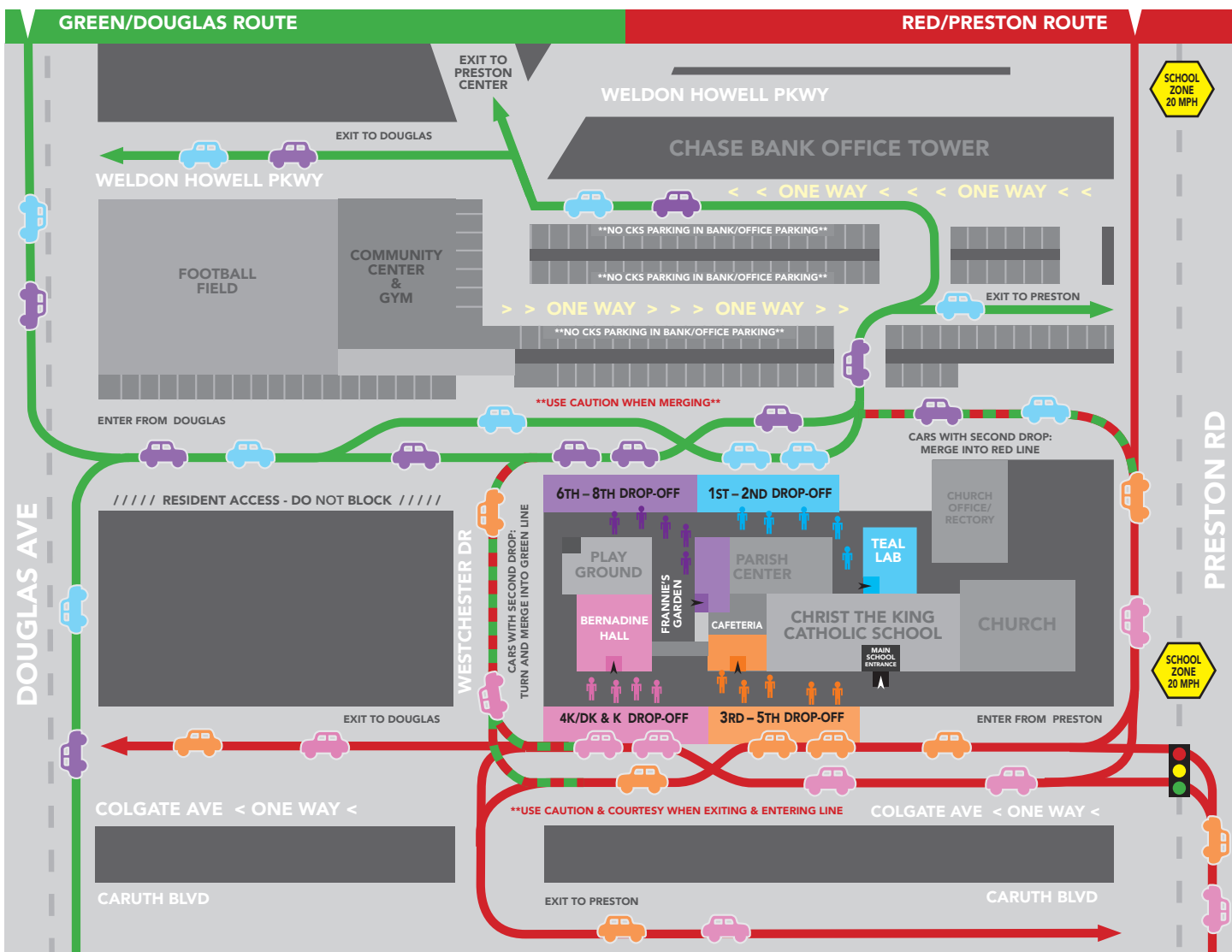

**RED/PRESTON ROUTE**

- **No cellphone use during active carpool.**
- Families that have children in multiple grades **MUST** drop each child at their designated drop area and then transition as shown with the dotted lines to the next drop area. Each family can choose the route and drop off sequence that works best for their family.
- **No walk-ins allowed.** Parents/caregivers must remain in their car. CKS personnel will assist the students out of the car.
- Please do not block traffic or sidewalk on Douglas Avenue.
- **No CKS parking permitted in adjacent Chase Bank/Office lot.** Be considerate of our adjacent residents and businesses.
- Drive slow and be cautious, courteous and patient with other drivers when merging, entering and exiting the carpool lines.

Students arriving after 7:50 are TARDY and will need to enter through the main school/office entrance on Colgate Ave. Each student will need to sign in at the office and get a tardy slip to give to his/her teacher upon arrival to class.



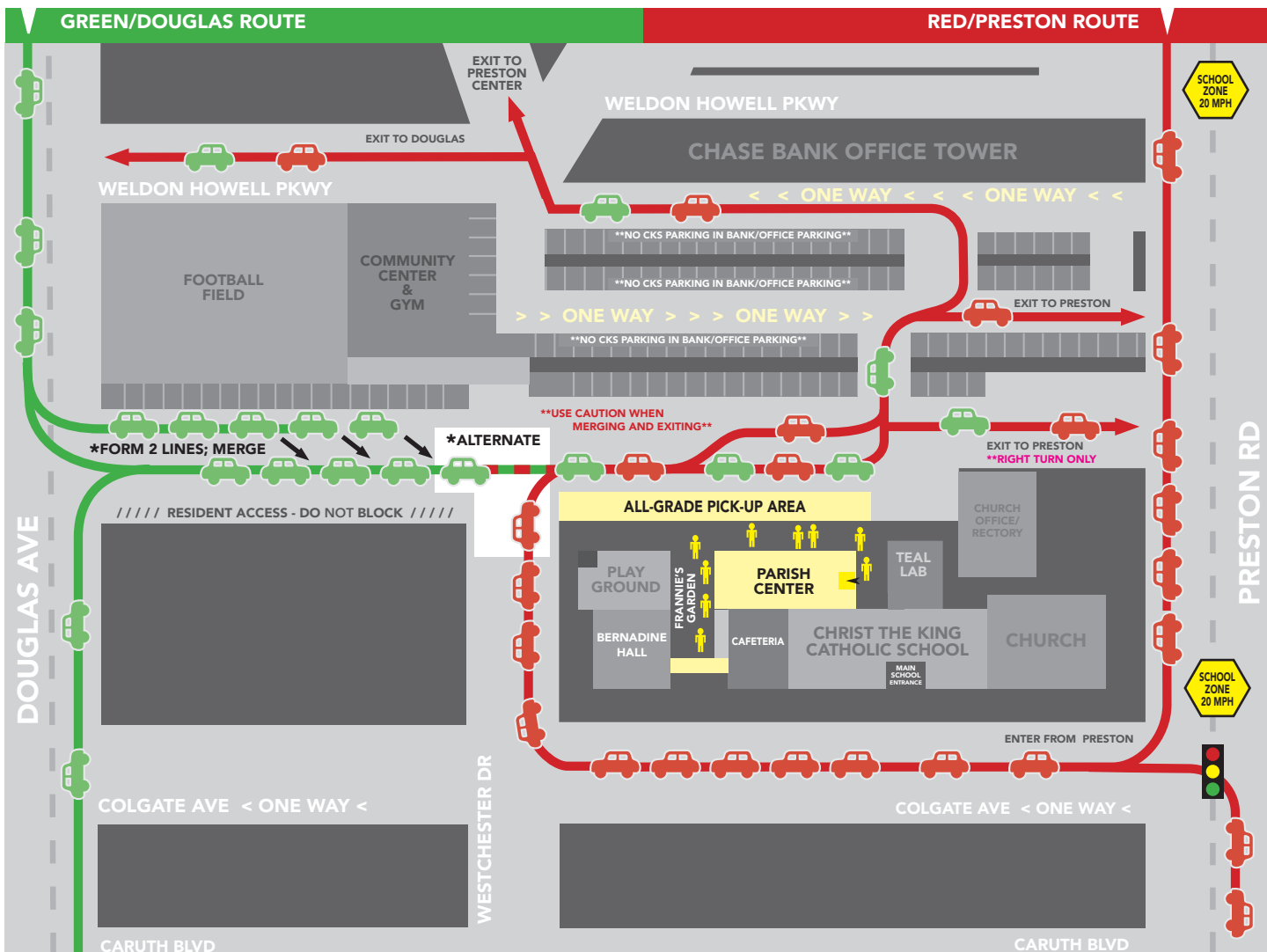
