10 Things You Can Do to Prepare for Returning Back to School

- Practice Hand Hygiene** often throughout the day. Teach them to sing their ABCs or count for at least 20 seconds, ensuring they wash the front, back, & in-between their fingers.
- Practice Putting Mask On/Off.** Your child will be required to wear a mask upon entering school & at all times. Teach them to not touch the outside/inside of their mask when taking it off/putting it on.
- Make/Purchase Extra Masks.** Masks should only be used one time. Consider making or buying multiple masks to give you the proper time to wash them between uses.
- Purchase a Thermometer.** Check your child's temperature every morning. If 100.0°F or higher, they must stay home and contact the CKS clinic for further instructions before returning to school. If they develop a fever at school, the parent will be notified and required to pick up the student.
- Practice Gift of Distance.** Measure the distance on the floor. Consider temporarily placing visual markers indicating 6' in your home.
- Update Immunizations & Physical.** Each is required to enroll for the school year. Contact your child's pediatrician for an appointment. Immunizations can also be obtained at the Health Dept.
- Change Aerosolized Medication.** Nebulizers & inhalers without a chamber cannot be administered in school. Speak with your child's pediatrician to obtain the proper equipment & to update the Asthma Action Plan.
- Purchase Reusable Water Bottle** to be brought to school. Water fountains will not be in service.
- Verify/Update Emergency Contacts.** If your child presents COVID-like symptoms, they will be placed in an isolation room and will need to be picked up immediately. Please ensure contact(s) can be reached at any time.
- Stay Informed.** Educate yourself from reliable sources such as the CDC (www.cdc.gov) and The Dallas County Department of Health (www.dallascounty.org) websites.
