Dear Parents,

Thank you for your commitment to a Christ the King Catholic School education. School leadership and the Advisory Council met to review critical issues in education and to discuss an effective strategic fiscal plan for the 2021-2022 school year. In that vein, and as discussed in more detail below, a tuition increase has been approved.

Importantly, the generosity of our entire CKS community, along with the sharing of time and talents, allows us to minimize the tuition change necessary to fulfill our mission through educational resources, safety protocols, HVAC updates, facility maintenance, utilities, and other costs. We are very sensitive to the economic impact on our families, and this decision is based upon a rigorous evaluation of our program costs, contemplating affordability while also cultivating an excellent educational experience for our students. The tuition change will support important CKS initiatives. Safety is a key priority, allowing our students to focus on their spiritual and academic growth, and we will continue with the Dallas Police on-campus presence. Summer projects will include classroom renovations, HVAC updates, and other facility updates.

Tuition per student rates for 2021-2022 are as follows:

Parishioner 4K-4th	\$9,721	an increase of \$283 or \$28.30 per month over 10 months
Parishioner 5th-8th	\$10,040	an increase of \$293 or \$29.30 per month over 10 months
Non-Parishioner 4K-4th	\$13,222	an increase of \$385 or \$38.51 per month over 10 months
Non-Parishioner 5th-8th	\$13,540	an increase of \$394 or \$39.44 per month over 10 months

Through prudent financial management and dedicated parent giving, Christ the King Catholic School is well-positioned to continue to provide a rigorous and relevant Catholic education. We offer quality curriculum and instruction, technology resources, school services for students, updates to our learning environment, experiential learning opportunities, and can compensate teachers competitively for their outstanding call to serve as professionals. We will continue to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to our care.

Online re-registration will be completed through two steps with RenWeb and FACTS Management Co. for all tuition and registration fees. All families, new and returning, will sign up for an actively managed payment plan. You will have the opportunity to pay in full or to schedule budgeted payments.

Christ the King Church will continue to give a generous annual investment so that the school's long-time Catholic tradition may bless this generation of students. If your family is on parishioner status, your stewardship to Christ the King Church must be up-to-date. If you are not, CKS's electronic system will automatically place your family on non-parishioner status for the year. Please contact the rectory to confirm your status.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve Christ the King Catholic School and to guide our mission. This year as a community, CKS chose strength instead of fear; resiliency and resourcefulness to continue to live our mission. Each day our Crusaders show courage, embrace opportunity and innovation, and share their gifts and talents with one another. We look forward to continuing our successful partnership with you to educate the hearts, minds, and spirits of our future servant leaders. May you continue to receive God's grace; to experience joy, love, and happiness; to share your blessings with others; and to know we are grateful that you are considering continuing your journey at Christ the King Catholic School next year for your family!

## BEEN EXPOSED TO COVID-19?

Be Informed: Know Your Next Steps

If you have trouble breathing or other serious symptoms, contact your physician for specific medical advice. This chart is intended for the general public, not health care workers.

COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS DISEASE



**YOU'VE BEEN EXPOSED TO COVID-19**  
This means you were **within 6 feet** of someone who tested positive (and you **contaminated**<sup>\*\*</sup> for **more than 15 minutes** with or without wearing a mask.

**YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS\*\***

**GET TESTED.**  
While waiting on your test results, be sure to stay home and away from others.

**YOU DID NOT OR COULD NOT GET TESTED**

**ISOLATE** and stay home until 10 days have passed since you first got symptoms; 24 hours have passed since you had a fever (without medication), and your symptoms have improved.  
**NOTE:** Anyone who lives with you needs to quarantine for 14 days since their last contact with you.

**YOU GOT TESTED**

**YOU TESTED POSITIVE**

**Quarantine** and stay home for 14 days since you were exposed to COVID-19. If you **MUST** go out, wear a mask and stay 6 feet away from anyone who doesn't live with you.

**YOU TESTED NEGATIVE**

**Quarantine** and stay home for 14 days since you were exposed to COVID-19. If you **MUST** go out, wear a mask and stay 6 feet away from anyone who doesn't live with you.

**YOU HAVE NO SYMPTOMS**

**CONSIDER GETTING TESTED.**  
Quarantine and wait at least 6 to 8 days before you test in order to avoid a possible false negative\*\*\* result.  
Keep in mind that when testing is in high demand, your results may be delayed by several days.

**YOU DID NOT OR COULD NOT GET TESTED**

**Quarantine** and stay home for 14 days since you were exposed to COVID-19. If you **MUST** go out, wear a mask and stay 6 feet away from anyone who doesn't live with you.

**YOU GET SYMPTOMS**

**GET TESTED.**  
While waiting on your test results, be sure to stay home and away from others.

**YOU GOT TESTED**

**YOU TESTED NEGATIVE**

**Quarantine** and stay home for 14 days since you were exposed to COVID-19. If you **MUST** go out, wear a mask and stay 6 feet away from anyone who doesn't live with you.

**YOU TESTED POSITIVE**

**Isolate** and stay home until 10 days have passed since you first got symptoms; 24 hours have passed since you had a fever (without medication), and your symptoms have improved.  
**NOTE:** Anyone who lives with you needs to quarantine for 14 days since their last contact with you.

**STILL NO SYMPTOMS**

Complete your 14-day quarantine starting from the day you were last exposed to COVID-19.

After your quarantine or isolation is over, you can resume normal activities. *But don't forget to wear a mask!*

\*\*People are contagious two days before they started having symptoms and at least 5 days after they stopped having symptoms. People who have no symptoms are considered contagious starting from the day before they got tested, through at least 5 days.  
\*\*\*A false negative test result is when the test result is negative when you actually are infected with COVID-19. This may happen when you test too soon after your exposure, and there is not enough virus in your system to be detected. Avoid a potential false negative by waiting approximately 6 days from when you were first exposed before you get tested.
