SUMMER UNIFORM (OPTIONAL)

Today is the first day students are permitted to wear their summer uniform. Please follow the Handbook Guidelines shown below.

The Summer Uniform is optional and may be worn on the first day upon return from Spring Break until November 1.

Boys (4K/DK)

- Uniform khaki elastic waistband shorts
- CKS crest red polo shirt
- Solid white crew socks. Crew socks should be long enough to cover the ankles when folded over.

Boys (Grades K - 8)

- Uniform khaki walking shorts
- CKS crest white polo shirt (Only a white t-shirt may be worn under optional polo shirt.)

Grade 8 only (optional) – CKS crest navy polo shirt

• Solid white crew socks. Crew socks should be long enough to cover the ankles when folded over.

Girls (4K/DK)

- CKS plaid skorts (knee length)
- CKS crest red polo shirt
- Solid white crew socks. Crew socks should be long enough to cover the ankles when folded over.

Girls (Grades K - 5)

- CKS plaid skorts (knee length)
- CKS crest white polo shirt (Only a white t-shirt or white/beige undergarments may be worn under optional polo shirt.)
- Solid white crew socks. Crew socks should be long enough to cover the ankles when folded over.

Girls (Grades 6 - 8)

• CKS uniform plaid skirt- all skirts should be
