

- We will verify students can access their online apps and provide training during computer class.


FACTS LMS

- FACTS has added a link to LMS so students can sign in from the Family Portal. The direct link is https://lms.renweb.com




FACTS LMS Class Dashboard

• This is the student dashboard showing their classes. Upcoming assignments will be listed in each box. Even if you do not see events, please click on the class to check for assignments.




FACTS LMS

 (red plus symbol).




Classlink

- Classlink is a signal sign-on platform that allows students to easily access all online content by storing usernames and passwords.
- File storage Classlink allows cloud storage to easily access files from any device. Students will have a class drive for assigned work and to upload completed assignments.




Classlink - App Page

- My Apps page
- Students app page may contain different apps by grade level
- Students can customize their app page by right clicking on the page and the clicking on change background.
- Click on the My Files tab at the bottom of the page to access shared files.

 - School Network Drives Legacy student drive
 - Cloud storage other sites




Office 365 Accounts

- Each student has an Office 365 account to access Microsoft Teams and Microsoft Stream apps.
- 2nd and 3rd grade students will not use the Outlook email app. New this year, 4th grade will utilize CKS student email.
- Microsoft Teams will be set up by homeroom and the homeroom teacher will email parents and students account with a link to join sessions.
- E-Learning students will follow their school schedule to view live sessions. Recordings to daily sessions will be posted on a homeroom Padlet for asynchronous viewing.
- Students can ask questions using the chat feature in Teams.

<u>Padlet</u>


- Padlet is an online app allowing users to post an array of content on a single page for easy access.












Seesaw

What is Seesaw?

Seesaw creates a powerful learning loop between teachers, students, and families.



Seesaw makes your child's thinking and learning visible

- Students complete assignments and post to their journal using the Class app
- Your child uses Seesaw learning tools like photo, draw + record and video to create, reflect and show their learning



Engage with your child's learning in real time on the Family app

- ✓ See and celebrate your child's growth
- ✓ Leave comments of encouragement
- ✓ Connect to all your children's journals in one place



Form strong partnerships with your child's teacher on the Family app

- ✓ Receive resources and announcements
- ✓ Message one-on-one with the teacher (group messaging is notavailable)
- Respond with typed messages or click the (+) to send photos, videos, and more

- **✓** Complete assignments




Families use the Family app

or log in as a Family Member at app.seesaw.me

- ✓ View and engage with their child's work
- **√** Communicate with theteacher

In the Family app, Families see posts by their child, posts their child is tagged in, and comments by the teacher or students on their child's posts







• The Journals tab allows you to view all posts by child or class



 Like or comment on any post in the Home or Journal tabs. Leave an audio comment by clicking the microphone icon



• **The Inbox tab** is where you receive announcements and message the teacher one-on-one (Group messages are not available)



• Attach a multimedia file to any message by clicking the plusicon



 Adjust account settings like notification preferences by clicking your profile icon top left



 Devices set to languages not English can translate all typed text in one click
