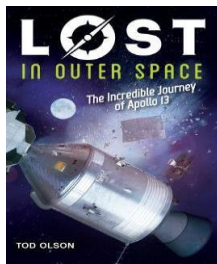


CKS Required Summer Assignments for 7th Graders Summer 2020
