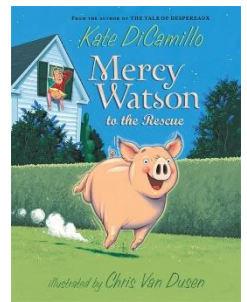


CKS Required Summer Assignments for 2nd Graders
