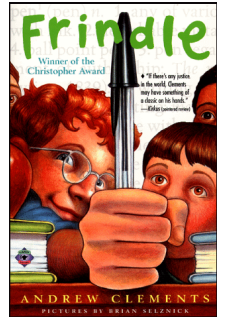


CKS Required Summer Assignments for 3rd Graders
