PURPOSE OF THE ANNUAL FUND

- Bridge the tuition Gap
- Fund the operating budget
- Minimize tuition increases
- Make possible the extras that provide excellence in CKS education

THE GAP FOR 2011-2012

- \$9,800 expenses per child, minus \$8,700 income per child = \$1,100 Gap per child
- Tuition provides about 75% of the cost to educate a child
- Sources of the remaining 25%
 - Church subsidy—\$300,000 per year
 - Endowment income—about \$115,000 per year
 - CKS Annual Fund and CKSPA Auction

WHAT ARE PARENTS ASKED TO GIVE?

- Parents are asked to help make up the Gap between what it costs to educate your child(ren) and the tuition you pay

HOW MUCH SHOULD YOU GIVE?

- Christ the King School depends on parents to give what you can
- CKS needs as many parents as possible to give the Gap
- CKS invites those parents who can to join the Principal's Circle
- CKS asks that each family give something. The school appreciates every gift, no matter what it may be. No gift is too small. Reaching 100% participation can be of great importance when the school seeks grant money from foundations. The school urges complete participation by suggesting several levels.
