#### Pastor's Report – Msgr. Zimmerman

- Building update: a few weeks behind, but delays were built in. Completion date still May.
- No CKS football on campus this fall. Homecoming probably at Jesuit, date tbd.
- Fundraising has been successful; pledge cards distributed to community 9/24-25.

#### Principal's Report – Ms. Seltzer

- Theme for yr is "Celebrating Catholic Identity"
- Great Expectations 9/7-8
- Summer repairs: elevator refurbishment; painting; soundproofing music room; installed wireless infrastructure; addition of dry erase boards in some classrooms; NetBook carts added
- Pending repairs: shade structures over playground, Franny's Garden (awaiting permit); cooling tower repair; energy management computer time; gutters
- Enrollment: 419 with 36 students lost from 10-11 and 34 gained this year; 41 kindergarten students which is low because of deferred enrollment
- Parish Center has been reserved exclusively for school use during the school day
- All improvements will be communicated to school community
