## Counselor Update

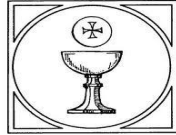

## **CKS to partner with the Brady Center for Thanksgiving and Christmas Drives**

Every year, CKS undertakes a food drive in November and clothing drive in December, benefitting the Brady Center. The Brady Center is one of Catholic Charities' Emergency Assistance Service Centers. Emergency Service Centers, run by Catholic Charities, annually serve 41,000 individuals who receive assistance in the form of clothing, rent and utilities.

At the Brady Center, located at 4009 Elm Street in East Dallas, caseworkers help needy families by providing for their most basic needs. The Brady Center also runs a food pantry, thrift store and a back to school program which assists with school shoes and supplies for roughly 1,000 children.

Another program at the Brady Center is the Elderly Services program in which some 300 seniors are enrolled. On any given day, approximately 100 seniors arrive at the center where they eat breakfast, socialize and hear presentations about diet and exercise. The Brady Center is a second home for many who would only be able to afford one meal a day.

Please support our food and clothing drives which will take place right before Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks.
