PURPOSE OF THE ANNUAL FUND

- Bridge the tuition Gap
- Fund the operating budget
- Minimize tuition increases
- Make possible the extras that provide excellence in a CKS education

THE GAP FOR 2021-2022

- The Gap is the difference between the actual cost of educating each student and tuition.
- \$950 Gap per student
- Tuition provides about 81% of the cost to educate a student. Sources of the remaining 19%:
 - Parish investment in the school of \$150,000 for the year
 - Endowment Trust Fund income averages \$100,000 per year
 - Grants
 - CKS Annual Fund

HOW MUCH SHOULD YOU GIVE?

- Parents are asked to help make up the Gap for each of their students.
- Christ the King School depends on parents to give what you can.
- CKS invites those parents who can to join the President's Circle.
- CKS asks that each family give something. The school appreciates every gift; no gift is too small. Our goal is 100% participation from our CKS families and staff. It is important to demonstrate to prospective donors outside the Christ the King community that CKS parents support the school. Foundations, corporations, and other major donors are more receptive when the entire school community demonstrates support through charitable giving.
