***COVID-19 Rules: Each Car must observe the current 'social distance rules', basically one family per car, if you have to leave the car in the Christ the King School parking lot, and observe 6' social distance. Remain in the car when driving by Monsignor***

#### **Schedule**

12:15

**Yard Signs:** If you or your organization wants to make and place a yard sign around Monsignor's Viewing Canopy, provide them to Brandon Madison by 12:15 PM on Colgate. This is where all the photos and videos will be taken.

**Car Decoration:** Feel free to decorate your car on the passenger side so Monsignor can see it. If you need to place it on the car in the parking lot, remain socially distant.

12:30

**Parking Lot Assembly:** Starting 12:30 Enter Christ the King School parking lot "Alley" from Douglas Avenue, as directed by volunteers to Preston Road

1:00 – 1:30

**Start:** At 1:00 the Dallas Police will start the caravan from the Christ the King School parking lot along the right lane of Preston Road to another Police officer at Colgate Avenue. Very similar to school drop off.

Follow volunteers' direction on Colgate in one or possibly two lanes of traffic

Each car will be able to drive slowly by Monsignor.

#### **Remain in your car**

Sing, blow whistles, play kazoos, etc., but please **DON'T HONK**, respecting him and the Colgate neighbors

**"Monsignor Mail":** A volunteer will take anything you would like to drop off **EXCEPT FOOD**, like letters, notes, etc. as you pass Monsignor. All items will remain in a box for 3 days before Monsignor sees them.
