## Christ the King Catholic School Dallas, Texas Named One of the Best in the Nation U.S. Department of Education Announces 2021 National Blue Ribbon Schools

U.S. Secretary of Education Miguel Cardona today recognized 325 schools as <u>National Blue Ribbon Schools</u> for 2021. The recognition is based on a school's overall academic performance or progress in closing achievement gaps among student subgroups. Secretary Cardona will make the announcement during his Return to School Road Trip, where he will visit an awardee school, <u>Walter R. Sundling Jr. High School</u>, in Palatine, Illinois.

"This year's cohort of honorees demonstrates what is possible when committed educators and school leaders create vibrant, welcoming, and affirming school cultures where rich teaching and learning can flourish," said Secretary Cardona. "I commend this school and all our Blue Ribbon honorees for working to keep students healthy and safe while meeting their academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs. In the face of unprecedented circumstances, you found creative ways to engage, care for, protect, and teach our children. Blue Ribbon Schools have so much to offer and can serve as a model for other schools and communities so that we can truly build back better."

The coveted National Blue Ribbon Schools award affirms the hard work of educators, families and communities in creating safe and welcoming schools where students master challenging and engaging content. Now in its 39th year, the National Blue Ribbon Schools Program has bestowed approximately 10,000 awards to more than 9,000 schools.

Christ the King Catholic School (CKS) has been recognized as a 2021 National Blue Ribbon School in the **Exemplary High-Performing School** category based on all student scores, subgroup student scores and graduation rates. The Exemplary High-Performing Schools are among their state's highest performing schools as measured by state assessments or nationally normed tests. There are 130,930 elementary and high schools in the United States. Only 325 schools were recognized this year, which means CKS is part of only .24% of the schools in the US to be named a 2021 National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. There are 32,461 private elementary and high schools in the US. Only 50 private schools were recognized, which means CKS is part of only .15% of private schools to be named a 2021 National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. This year, CKS is the only Catholic school recognized in the state of Texas! CKS has been recognized three times and is one of only a select few schools with back to back National Blue Ribbon School recognitions: 2021, 2015, 1994.

Up to 420 schools may be nominated each year. The Department invites National Blue Ribbon Schools nominations from the top education official in all states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, the Department of Defense Education Activity, and the Bureau of Indian Education. Private schools are nominated by the Council for American Private Education.
