SAFE ENVIRONMENT:

Instructions for online training and retraining

Welcome to a new year at Christ the King Catholic Community and School. We are glad that you are back, and we are anxious to see you active here at Christ the King.

Thank you for keeping up with your Safe Environment training. This year may be a bit different for some of you. All training and retraining will be online this year using a new video from the Diocese of Dallas. Hopefully, the following instructions will make this a smooth process.

Use this link: <https://dallas.setanet.org/obligations.php>. You will need to sign in with your legal name (the one you used when you submitted your Screening Form) and the address that you submitted on that form, unless you have made updates to your personal information. Once you have successfully logged in, you will be asked to update your information (if needed) and the system will direct you from there.

These online courses must be watched in one sitting and the self-assessment taken immediately after viewing the video (it may take 60 seconds or more to load), so make sure to leave yourself enough time for both. DO NOT exit the program until you have received notice that you passed the self-assessment, as you cannot go back in. Once you receive verification of completion/credit, print off the verification certificate. You may scan it to me if you wish, but this is not necessary as the system should update your file automatically. However, please file that verification away in case the system somehow fails (it does happen occasionally.)

Additionally, since distance learning will be such an important part of education as we begin the new school year and most communication will be from a distance, our use of computers, internet, and even Social Media figure more prominently in our educational lives than ever before. In light of this, it is especially important to assure a clear understanding of all Diocese of Dallas policies relating to the use of these tools. 10 Things You Can Do to Prepare for Returning Back to School

- 1 Practice Hand Hygiene** often throughout the day. Teach them to sing their ABCs or count for at least 20 seconds, ensuring they wash the front, back, & in-between their fingers.
- 2 Practice Putting Mask On/Off.** Your child will be required to wear a mask upon entering school & at all times. Teach them to not touch the outside/inside of their mask when taking it off/putting it on.
- 3 Make/Purchase Extra Masks.** Masks should only be used one time. Consider making or buying multiple masks to give you the proper time to wash them between uses.
- 4 Purchase a Thermometer.** Check your child's temperature every morning. If 100.0°F or higher, they must stay home and contact the CKS clinic for further instructions before returning to school. If they develop a fever at school, the parent will be notified and required to pick up the student.
- 5 Practice 6ft of Distance.** Measure the distance on the floor. Consider temporarily placing visual markers indicating 6' in your home.
- 6 Update Immunizations & Physical.** Each is required to enroll for the school year. Contact your child's pediatrician for an appointment. Immunizations can also be obtained at the Health Dept.
- 7 Change Aerosolized Medication.** Nebulizers & inhalers without a chamber cannot be administered in school. Speak with your child's pediatrician to obtain the proper equipment & to update the Asthma Action Plan.
- 8 Purchase Reusable Water Bottle** to be brought to school. Water fountains will not be in service.
- 9 Verify/Update Emergency Contacts.** If your child presents COVID-like symptoms, they will be placed in an isolation room and will need to be picked up immediately. Please ensure contact(s) can be reached at any time.
- 10 Stay Informed.** Educate yourself from reliable sources such as the CDC (www.cdc.gov) and The Dallas County Department of Health (www.dallascounty.org) websites.
