ERB's Comprehensive Testing Program May 4th-6th - Grades 2-7

Dear Parents,

Students in grades 2-7 will be taking ERB's Comprehensive Testing Program (CTP) this week. The CTP is an achievement assessment produced by ERB-a not-for-profit member organization that has provided student assessment services for over 90 years.

The CTP is a summative assessment of learning achievement. Its purpose is to identify the academic strengths and weaknesses of both individual students and groups of students. This enables CKS to make informed decisions about programs, curriculum, and resources to best meet students' needs.

The CTP is comprised of individual subtests to assess different subject areas. The subtests your student takes will vary depending on your student's current grade level. The questions on each CTP subtest are further classified into content strands or domains that identify the specific skill each question is designed to measure.

You will receive an Individual Subscore Report that will describe your student's CTP performance on different subtests and content strands. You will receive Scale Scores, Percentiles, and Stanines that display your student's relative performance on each subtest when compared to various norm groups. The Student Profile Analysis will display your student's content mastery scores on each subtest and content strand.

Student Tips

- Get a good night's sleep each night. (There will not be any homework during testing.)
- Eat a balanced breakfast, and bring a snack and water to school each day.
- Be positive and confident. (These tests are not for a grade. They are used to support your learning.)
