Subject: COVID-19 Parent Communication

Dear Parents,

As we continue to learn of more coronavirus (COVID-19) cases within the United States, we would like to update you on the precautions CKS is taking, especially as Spring Break is approaching. Attached you will also find communication from the Diocese of Dallas Catholic Schools Office. The Diocese of Dallas and Christ the King Catholic School are in communication with the county health department, and we are closely monitoring the coronavirus situation.

CKS has a third party cleaning service that is currently deep cleaning the campus nightly as per specific disinfection protocols. This includes disinfecting hard services (i.e. door handles, desks, chairs, etc.) In addition to the nightly deep cleans, CKS has scheduled sanitation services upon return from Spring Break.

In the event of a school closure, CKS will activate e-learning via a student information system (SIS) platform. Throughout the next two weeks, teachers will review accessibility information with the students.

The Catholic Schools Office has given each campus an international travel screening form to be used in scenarios when a student is exhibiting symptoms and has traveled internationally. This form will begin to be utilized in the CKS clinic upon return from Spring Break. (The form is attached for your review.) The health and safety of our students, faculty, and staff are our top priorities. We are here to support you. Please let me know if you have any questions.
