FACTS & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE CRUSADER FUND?

The Crusader Fund is made up of annual gifts from alumnae, parents, parents of alumnae, faculty and staff, grandparents, and friends of Christ the King Catholic School. These unrestricted funds are added to the general fund of the school's budget for use in meeting current operating expenses, faculty enrichment programs, safety and security on campus, and enhancing the programs and services offered to the students.

WHY DOES MY PARTICIPATION MATTER?

A gift to the Crusader Fund is a meaningful expression of confidence in the strength and impact of our entire school program.

DOES CKS ACCEPT MATCHING GIFTS

Company matching is encouraged to maximize giving. Please check with your company's HR Department to find out if your company matches.

ARE CRUSADER FUND GIFTS TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

Yes, but always consult your tax advisor to determine the deductibility of this contribution.

WHAT TIME PERIOD DOES THE CRUSADER FUND COVER?

The Crusader Fund is run on a fiscal year basis. Solicitations for gifts begin in September and all gifts recorded before June 30 will be credited during the campaign year. The funds are applied to the current year's operating budget, which runs from July 1 through June 30.

CAN I ADD THE AMOUNT OF MY DONATION TO COVER TUITION?

No. Tuition is a payment for services and your Crusader Fund gift is a contribution.
