<i>Event</i>	<i>Materials to Bring to Testing Location</i>
Art Memory	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
Creative Writing	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen (5-6 sheets of lined paper provided)
Impromptu Speaking	Writing Utensil and Blank Paper (to initially organize ideas on; may not be used when giving speech)
Listening Skills	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; 2 Sheets of Blank Paper (with or without lines)
Maps, Graphs & Charts	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; An atlas (Nystrom Desk Atlas 2016 or newer addition), a ruler, and a magnifying glass (can be brought into the test)
Mathematics	#2 Pencils with good erasers
Music Memory	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
Number Sense	Blue (ONLY) ball point or ink pen
On-site Drawing	Drawing media (CANNOT require water, oil or a brush); Watercolor markers acceptable; Other acceptable media: pencil, charcoal, craypas, pastels, and ink pens (not requiring a separate bottle of ink)
Prose/Poetry Interpretation	Small, Dark colored folder (class folder with brads and pockets) containing individual Prose/Poetry work with Verification Documentation in the pocket; speak with Mrs. Garnett to get documentation verification
Ready Writing	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen; Notebook Paper
Science	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
Spelling	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
Vocabulary	#2 Pencils with good erasers and blue/black pen
